

DIGITIZING PROJECT

The Loup City Alumni Association, in conjunction with Loup City High School, has been working to have Alumni class composite photos scanned and optimized. These “digitized” photos will then be accessible on a dedicated monitor in the Loup City High School Commons Area. Alumni can be searched by name or year of graduation. This project is funded by the Loup City Alumni Association and the Sherman County Community Foundation. The goal is to have all of the Alumni photos from 1956 through 2016 digitized by the 2017 Alumni Reunion.

The Alumni Association would also like to have graduating classes before 1956 digitized. However, class composites were damaged by water at the old High School and subsequently destroyed. Yearbooks are not available for 1946 and earlier. The Sherman County Historical Society has been of assistance, but they, too have incomplete records.

If you still have wallet-sized photos, a class composite, or a yearbook for 1946 or earlier, the Alumni Association would like your help in making the digitized Alumni directory more complete.
