

City of Loup City - Special Meeting

January 13, 2015 – 2:00 p.m.

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Loup City convened in special session on January 13, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. Notice of the Special Meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in the following three public places on January 12, 2015: City Office, Post Office, Sherman County Courthouse. Said notice of the meeting contained the statement that the agenda kept continually current was available to the public in the office of the City Clerk during normal business hours.

Mayor Baillie announced that the meeting of Mayor and Council is an open meeting. The City of Loup City abides by the Open Meeting Act in conducting business. A copy of the Open Meetings Act is displayed in the front and back of the Council Chambers as required by law. The City Council may vote to go into closed session on any agenda item as allowed by State law.

All proceedings were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public. Mayor Baillie called the meeting to order. Upon roll call by the City Clerk the following were present: Tricia Kuszak, Milt Walrath, Kyle Kowalski, Alan Oseka.

Mayor Baillie asked that all those present join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. He asked for a moment of silence to remember all Armed Forces Service Personnel and all Volunteers who help keep us safe.

Presentations were given to the City Council from Adam Collins representing BCBS and United Health Care and Clint Ruether representing Federated explaining their health care plans. A motion was made by Walrath and seconded by Kowalski to select the Federated Health Choice Plan # 1416 as the Health Insurance for City employees.
